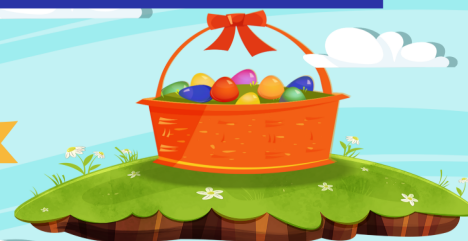

## SUMMARY OF JANUARY'S VOTER'S MEETING

- At the January 27th quarterly voter's meeting the voters accepted the transfer of the Voss family to Good Shepherd FDL. They also approved the removal of Bob McClanathan as well as James & Stacy Hendricks. The transfer of Wally & Kathy Hennig from St. Lucas, Kewaskum, & Dan & Greta Scharp from Bethlehem, Menomonee Falls were ratified by the voters, and Dick Runge was accepted into membership by profession of faith.

- The school is currently working through the accreditation process for school choice, and would like to hire a fourth teacher starting for the 2024-2025 school year.

- JAM time is going well with 10-15 children attending each session. The Epiphany dinner went well with 66 meals served. The funds from the dinner have been designated for the school's mission fund.

-The shepherding committee continues to work through it's list of members with some progress made last quarter. Evangelism ideas for this summer's parades include distributing flyers to announce an open house at our new church.

- School and church properties have been doing well and snow removal has been hired out for the season. The building project continues to move forward, with a short delay due to inspections and cold weather.

-The voter's passed a resolution to set tuition rates for the 2024/2025 school year at TLS at \$1000.00 for members & Christian education students, and \$4000.00 for sister WELS students.

-Dan Hornburg has been elected to serve on the WLA Plenary Board
