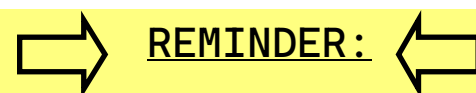

ORGANIZATION OF WELS LUTHERAN SENIORS OWLS – CHAPTER 77 – LOMIRA/FOND DU LAC

The next meeting of Flyway OWLS (Chapter 77) will take place Tuesday, April 9, 2024, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Lomira Community Center (425 Water Street, Lomira).

Our speaker for April is Bruce Braun. He went on 3 different mission trips to Ukraine in 2004, 2005, and 2006. The first trip was with the ELS with thoughts of Faith. The last two trips were with Wisconsin Lutheran College, where he is a professor of education.

His interest in Ukraine began because both sides of his mother's family, the Knulls and the Buelows, had settled there in Ukraine. There is much more to his story, which he will explain in his power point presentation.

We will collect dues for 2024 (\$20 per person). The dues went from \$15.00 to \$20.00 per year at the annual convention held in October. With the cost of everything going up, it was necessary to make this change. These dues go directly to the National OWLS office in New Ulm, MN to cover their office expenses and printing expenses. We take a free will offering at each meeting to pay any expenses we may incur locally such as our speakers and support for the European Civilian Chaplaincy program.
