#### ORGANIZATION OF WELS LUTHERAN SENIORS OWLS – CHAPTER 77 – LOMIRA/FOND DU LAC

The next meeting of Flyway OWLS (Chapter 77) will take place Tuesday, May 14, 2024, beginning at 1:00 p.m. in the multi-purpose room at St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac.

Our speaker will be Sean Young, senior director of WELS mission operations, about WELS involvement in communist Vietnam mission work. He says in the same way, the gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the whole world-just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and truly understand God's grace, God's grace and the gospel message has been working in the hearts of the Hmong people in Vietnam. Through connections only the Lord can provide, WELS has been providing theological training to members of the Hmong Fellowship Church (HFC) in Vietnam since 2011. In the years WELS has provided training, the HFC has grown from 55,000 to over145,000 members and formed many new churches thanks to the peace that only the message of free grace received from Jesus Christ can provide.

We will collect dues for 2024 (\$20 per person). The dues went from \$15.00 to \$20.00 per year at the annual convention held in October. With the cost of everything going up, it was necessary to make this change. These dues go directly to the National OWLS office in New Ulm, MN to cover their office expenses and printing expenses. We take a free will offering at each meeting to pay any expenses we may incur locally such as our speakers and support for the European Civilian Chaplaincy program.
